

History Moment: On October 7, 1913, Henry Ford's Model T Assembly Line in Highland Park, MI, began to move. Based on the concept he had seen at Chicago meat processing facilities, where carcasses moved along overhead rails, Ford attached each chassis to a rope pulled along the assembly line by a motor, producing a Model T every 93 minutes. This technique ultimately reduced the cost of a Model T from \$850 to \$360 and transformed the American auto industry.
